The Kiss-Off Commentaries

I've been informed that this issue is to be our last internet magazine publication. There will be no more. Well, I always had a free hand at what I wrote with the exceptions of some comments I made concerning bayonets and the body parts of certain judges and politicians. To ensure this, I am watching what I write very closely.

As entertaining as some of the handwritten pages I've turned in has been to one of our editors and one writer, the subjects I cover are serious matters. I would like to close out now with a very serious matter. I'm writing about the matter of survival and the survival of the Constitutional Republic.

My own personal survival and the survival of those close to me are very serious matters indeed. On an individual basis this level of survival is at the

foremost of our preparations. It needs to be as survival of the individual is necessary to the survival of the Republic.

This once great nation was built by individuals who formed a limited government to perform some very specific tasks. Those tasks were written down very clearly in the Constitution. The tasks specified therein are the only tasks government has the authority to perform. Any task government undertakes outside those specified are criminal acts. This has not stopped those holding government office from unlawfully usurping powers to perform tasks beyond the scope of constitutional government. Often these criminal acts are prompted by global bankster corporations. These are the guys David Korten talked about (himself included) when he said, "The dream of the corporate empire builders is being realized. The global system is harmonizing standards across country after country - down toward the lowest common denominator. " One Rockefeller or another at one time uttered, "Give me control over a nation's money and I care not who makes it's laws." To gain control of what once was the American Republic these banksters have bought political offices and politicians that have no interest in working for the interest of Americans. Politicians now work for their bankster masters who buy them their offices.

Our early Republic was a masterful balance that placed political power in the hands of individuals, yet allowed for a limited government to perform the tasks necessary to provide for the common defense and welfare (not the current meaning of welfare) of the country. This placed the day to day business of survival and living in the hands of individuals. The responsibility for providing for one's own survival was wholly one's own. Such responsibility may seem overwhelming to today's generation, yet such responsibility is essential to preserve the maximum amount of Rights, freedom and liberty endowed upon individuals by their Creator.

What happens when a vast majority of a nation's Citizenry no longer has the know-how or backbone to embrace this responsibility and provide for their families' living and survival? In a couple of words, "New Orleans." The aftermath of New Orleans caused by the hurricanes Katrina and Rita points out dramatically the dangers of a stupid, welfare

dependent public. The stupid people of New Orleans actually expected government to provide them with safety and the provisions of life in the face of wide spread disaster. This is something that is impossible for governments to provide and stupid to expect. Those who expect government to provide a living and for individual survival during a disaster are allowing government far more scope and power than was intended by the founders. A government powerful enough to provide a living and means of survival for you is powerful enough to control that living and survival. This is exactly the opposite of the preservation of freedom and exactly what the founders fought eight long, bloody years from which to separate the several States.

This puts the responsibility of your survival and that of your family squarely on your shoulders. When government failed to come to the rescue of millions of New Orleans, the public in that city degraded into a mob greedily grabbing everything not theirs and adding to the chaos. This goes for the police, national guard and other "authorities" sent in to steal guns and evict Citizens from perfectly safe homes while shooting pets in their own yards. If government "officials" ever wanted to get shot, this is certainly one of the best ways to go about it. Government was just lucky that beside being stupid, New Orleans are for the most part gutless. There were some who resisted. Mainly elderly ladies and men who the police and guardsmen felt secure enough to brutalize and beat. Others were surrounded by guardsmen with heavy weapons and intimidated into surrender of their property. Too bad New Orleans didn't have a constitutional militia to surround the bad guys and arrest them for attempted theft of property. Or the bad guys could have started a war leading to the restoration of lawful government. Either way order could have been restored had the Citizenry been smart enough to know what lawful government actually was.

AND had they been prepared to provide for their own living and survival! A people educated to assume the responsibility for their own survival would likely to have been prepared for the disaster that had befallen New Orleans. I don't doubt that there would have been some criminal elements, but they would have been fewer and farther between and the armed civil populous would have protected themselves from

lawbreakers as they should have done against the criminal actions of the police while stealing firearms.

This brings us back to you and your responsibility. What does it take to provide for your own and your family's survival? Just a bit of focus. You know what you need to survive. Shelter, water, food, heat. You need to spend your income wisely. Your home can be your shelter. It must accommodate your entire family, but does it have to be a mansion? How much "stuff" do you need to cram in to your shelter? Is a large screen TV necessary when a cheaper, smaller model will due, especially when the difference in price will buy you several months of storage food? If you are thinking about buying a jet ski for some play time, why not get a small boat and fishing gear instead? A leisurely ride around a lake while hooking some lunch goes a longer way toward survival than a flashy toy that will zip you around the water without any other benefits than emptying your wallet. Keeping a mind to your responsibility and focusing on your budget will provision you with what you need for your own survival.

In this day and age your personal survival entails more than just preparing for natural disasters or hard times like economic depressions. We have an out of control government which has transitioned into an evil empire. Government has become totalitarian in nature incorporating collectivist/communist principals to govern the populous. When dissatisfaction begins to rear in the populous, government employs terrorism to keep its control on power. In the past such terrorism took the form of simple ambushes and murders like that employed against Gordon Kahl and recently against William Cooper. Some murders took a more direct approach as at Ruby Ridge, Idaho where a family decided to exercise their Rights and live as they saw fit. Government mistakenly believed the Weavers had more involvement than was reality with a group under investigation at Hayden Lake. To coerce Randy Weaver into working for the government as an informant, the BATF framed Mr. Weaver with a faulty mark on a shotgun barrel, then changed his court date without informing him. When Mr. Weaver didn't show for the new date which he was unaware of, government issued an arrest warrant and attacked his family, murdering his son and dog and attempting to murder family friend Kevin Harris. The FBI assassin squad lost their nerve when resisted

and covered in the woods overnight before running back down the mountain. An army of "law enforcement" was called out the next day and further assassin squads were inserted after which Mr. Weaver's wife Vicki was murdered by sniper Lon Horriuchi. Despite the demonization spewed out by the propaganda networks the truth got out about the situation at Ruby Ridge and patriotic groups showed up with cameras just in time to stop a helicopter from dropping a fire bomb on the Weaver's shack.

The surviving Weavers survived to tell their side to a jury. When their side came out, the government had lost it's case except for the false charge of missing a court date, the evidence of which was hidden from the jury. In later interviews the jurors said they would not have voted guilty on that count either had they been allowed to hear that the courts had neglected to tell Mr. Weaver of the change in dates.

The massacre of the Seventh Day Adventist Branch Davidians at the Church of Mt. Carmel, Waco, Texas occurred two years later. Again, the members of this Church wished to exercise their Rights and live as they believed. Government can't abide Citizens who exercise their Rights and live freely. If ideas of freedom were to spread, government would loose much of it's usurped powers, so in came the accusations, tanks and media demonization. After government was sure it's propaganda was at full effect, it attacked and burned down the Church with women and children inside and shot most of those who tried to run out of the conflagration.

These murderous terror tactics began to backfire on government at this point. After Ruby Ridge and Waco many Americans felt it prudent to band together to defend their families from similar terrorist attacks. Taking their cue from the early founders, Americans forming defensive groups called themselves militia. America's early militias were formed to perform the same function. With Slick Willie (the most untrustworthy president in US history) in office Americans knew they needed to protect themselves from government atrocities.

Government had to reverse this situation and pulled out an old trick from Adolph Hitler. As Adolph burned the Reichstadt, government chose a convenient location to bomb one of it's own

buildings. Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, the Edward R Murrah federal building held government official papers regarding the mass murder at Waco, Texas. By blowing up their own federal building, government accomplished two things. They destroyed evidence as to their guilt in a mass murder and attack on innocent Citizens and shifted public sympathy toward government instead of government's victims.

This did not immediately work. Only after several staged attacks did this tactic begin to work. First on the most stupid, then on a majority of the populous. Until, now, the traditions of America and the rugged individualism that made her great are feared and thought to be anathema to a large majority.

This is your greatest threat to survival today. You have two approaches to meet this threat. You can either hide from it. Lay low and lay in supplies and hope government doesn't notice you and pass the problem on to your children. It will get worst in your children's time. They may not have the option of laying low. Your second option is to prepare for active resistance. Take a low profile approach as to your preparations, but be active in forming a plan of resistance. Don't be silent as to government tyranny and criminal acts. Educate neighbors as to the true form of America's government and their Rights.

This brings us to the connection between individual survival and the survival of the American Republic. In a lawful government, government performs only those tasks specifically delegated to it by the Constitution. We The People have lost lawful government somewhere down the line. The totalitarian government we have today has usurped powers far beyond it's authority. Government uses noble sounding excuses to perform tasks not within it's power like providing for individual survival during a disaster, providing a decent living for those less fortunate (welfare), providing education (actually brainwashing and controlling what your children learn) and the ever popular, "It's for the chillldren 'sob'." Though, these excuses sound noble, a look at the action taken by government to provide the people with them is far more insidious. Any action government performs that is not specifically delegated to it is a criminal act. Beside committing a crime while performing tasks outside it's authority, anything government has the power to provide, it has the power

to control. I don't know about you, but I don't want a totalitarian government or any other to control my livelihood, education or especially my ability to survive! From such examples as the disasters in New Orleans and Florida and past government actions as Ruby Ridge and Waco, it should be extremely evident that the responsibility for personal survival *must* remain with each individual. And indeed, if you think about it, does!

When government takes the responsibility of living and survival onto it's shoulders, we can see that problems caused by natural or man made disasters are compounded. Government does not work efficiently. It does not, nor can not, deliver supplies and help directly to each individual. Only other individuals can do that.

Americans for the sake of their own plans for survival must become active in politics with the goal of keeping government small and limited. The forefathers knew this as they had to live their lives day to day and saw first hand the evils of government intervention in their lives. They wrote The Declaration Of Independence, the Constitution and The Bill Of Rights to prevent government from growing beyond it's bounds and threatening the lives of Citizens. Americans do not need to invent anything new to secure their lives, liberty, happiness and survival. Americans merely need to know what lawful government is and how it is to function. It is freedom that allows us to prosper and provide for our own futures and survival. The opposite of freedom is slavery or collectivism. Collectivism redistributes what you have worked to provide for yourself to others in most inefficient manners. It has been tried and failed by most cultures around the world and Americans must insure that it's poisonous spread in America is stopped.

Collectivist ideas can be easily spotted by comparing the policies of government to the most collectivist document of all, *The Ten Planks Of The Communist Manifesto*. It's principals follow as such;

- 1.) The abolition of private property. (Property taxes hiked too high for many to afford to keep the homes they supposedly own.)
- 2.) Heavy progressive income tax. (IRS)

3.) Abolition on all Rights of inheritance. (Now being accomplished through the inheritance tax.)

4.) Confiscation of property of all emigrants and rebels. (RICCO statutes allow for the theft of any property the Police "suspect" of having been used in a crime.)

5.) Establishment of a central bank. (Came about in 1913 replacing America's constitutional money with debt based phony reserve notes.)

6.) Government control of communications and transportation. (Government controls most communications through the FCC. All mainstream media today is owned by a handful of multi-national corporations who, coincidentally, own the politicians holding government office. Government controls transportation through phony oil crunches and artificially inflated fuel prices.)

7.) Government ownership of factories and agriculture. (This has actually turned around to the corporations that own government owning America's factories and agriculture. America's factories have been sold and transported to the Chinese communists while agriculture is firmly in the hands of large agri-corps. Through immoral banking practices, family farms have been forced out of the ownership of Families and have been acquired by agricultural corporations.)

8.) Government control of labor. (Ever try getting a job without your socialist security number? I only know one person who has done it. Your labor history is tracked and your earnings are sucked from you through taxation. Still think government doesn't control your labor?)

9.) Establishment of corporate farms and regional ecological planning. (Accomplished through the use of immoral banking practices to take family farms out of the hands of families and placed into the hands of super large corporations. regional ecological planning is taking place through zoning regulations and so called "green laws".)

10.) Government control of education. (Accomplished with the "No Student Left Behind Program" and fronts like the NEA.)

In direct contrast to the above piece of garbage, the founders believed that human beings were endowed with certain unalienable Rights. That these Rights were not granted by governments and governments had no control over the exercise of these Rights. The founders later enumerated some of these Rights in The Bill Of Rights. Government may in no way interfere with these Rights. The Bill Of Rights is as follows;

Article 1.

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

Article 2.

A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Article 3.

No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner, nor in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law.

Article 4.

The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.

Article 5.

No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the Militia, when in actual service in time of War or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offence to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation.

Article 6.

In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defence.

Article 7.

In Suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury, shall be otherwise re-examined in any Court of the United States, than according to the rules of the common law.

Article 8.

Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

Article 9.

The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.

Article 10.

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

The above enumerated Rights are what helps us to secure our own survival and make a living for ourselves. When contrasting the two very different documents it is not difficult to see which philosophy government has chosen to follow. It is in the best interest of We The People to restore lawful government and force it back within the limits which the founders envisioned to secure our happiness and survival. Unless we do, we have future New Orleans, Wacos, loss of liberty and freedoms and more government staged 9-11's to look forward to. I do not know where we are going from here.
